Discover this architectural masterpiece that seamlessly blends contemporary design with nature. This 815 m² villa, set on a 4,139 m² plot, stands out for its fluid lines and passive design, featuring exposed concrete with high thermal inertia. Its entrance is a true spectacle, with a natural bamboo bridge over water leading to an impressive foyer, where a six meter tall ficus bonsai rises from a reflecting pond, illuminated by natural light streaming through a glass ceiling. Inspired by Frank Lloyd Wright and Mies van der Rohe, the villa appears to float over interconnected water elements, creating a serene and harmonious living experience.

It offers five luxurious bedrooms, including a master suite with two walk in closets that open onto a private garden filled with conifers and jasmine. The ensuite bathroom features a retractable glass ceiling for starlit showers, complemented by luxurious brass fixtures from Noken. The villa perfectly combines elegance and functionality, boasting details such as a floating bridge connecting the east and west wings, a fully equipped kitchen, and a minimalist...
