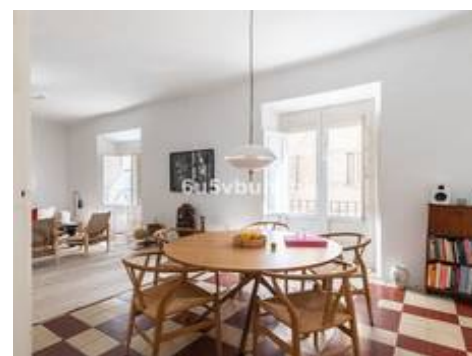




Description

Hidden within the historic streets of central Málaga, this remarkable courtyard house captures a way of living that has shaped Mediterranean homes for centuries.

From the moment you enter, the house reveals its character: a generous open-air patio framed by elegant stone columns and wooden beams, where sunlight pours in from above and the atmosphere feels peaceful and timeless. Homes organised around a central courtyard have been part of Mediterranean life since antiquity, from the Roman domus to the patio houses of Andalusia.

This is not a palace but something rarer — a true home shaped by history. Original tiles, handcrafted details and beautiful wooden doors and windows have been carefully preserved throughout. The courtyard design also creates a naturally calm interior climate, a quality that has made this architectural tradition so enduring in Mediterranean cities.

The property offers 416 m² distributed across three levels organised around the central patio.
